

#### RECREATION PROGRAMS

# I. GENERAL

This Alabama Department of Corrections (ADOC) Administrative Regulation (AR) establishes responsibilities, policies, and procedures for the management of recreation and leisure time programs for inmates.

### II. <u>POLICY</u>

It is the policy of the ADOC that recreation and leisure time programs for inmates shall be available in all facilities.

#### III. DEFINITIONS AND ACRONYMS

#### IV. <u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u>

- A. The Warden/Designee is responsible for:
  - 1. Developing the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) as necessary for the implementation of this AR;
  - 2. Designating a staff member to develop comprehensive recreation program that includes leisure time activities of interest to the inmates.
- B. The Facility Recreation Program Coordinator is responsible for:
  - 1. Maintenance of a monthly comprehensive schedule of recreation programs available at the facility;

- 2. Issue, control, and maintenance of a current inventory of all recreational equipment and supplies;
- 3. Securing proper approval for all recreational activities, including tournaments, and provide necessary coordination with all sections affected;
- 4. Training inmates who will assist staff in various aspects of the recreational program;
- C. ADOC employees and inmates are responsible for complying with this regulation.

#### V. PROCEDURES

#### A. Staffing:

- 1. The work schedule of the recreational staff shall be flexible to ensure inmate access to facilities and supervised programs;
- 2. Community interaction through recreation activities is encouraged;
- 3. Recreational activities shall not interfere with work, academic, and vocational programs.

#### B. Facilities and Equipment:

- 1. Suitable space for recreation or leisure time activities shall be available as designated by the Warden/Designee at each facility for inmate use;
- Equipment and supplies shall be available at each facility in proportion to the inmate population. Equipment and supplies shall be maintained in good condition.

#### C. Inmate Participation:

- 1. All inmates shall be encouraged and permitted to take part in leisure time and recreation activities, except where participation may be temporarily restricted for reasons of discipline, security, or health;
- 2. An inmate shall not be forced or coerced into participation.
- 3. Inmates shall forward all requests for recreational/leisure time activities to the Warden/Designee. The Warden/Designee shall have the authority to grant permission for these activities, provided they are consistent with security needs of the facility and that adequate staff is available for supervision;

4. Inmates may not participate in martial arts, boxing, wrestling, or any activity deemed inappropriate by the Warden/Designee.

# VI. <u>DISPOSITION</u>

Any forms used will be disposed of and retained according to the Departmental Records Disposition Authority (RDA).

# VIII. <u>SUPERSEDES</u>

This Administrative Regulation supersedes AR 447, *Recreation Programs*, dated August 17, 2005, and any changes.
